This seminar will focus on Transition to Advanced level work to help people that want to advance beyond junior hunter level work as well as those that already compete at the higher levels. The seminar will be supplemented with yard drills that will enhance handling and marking concepts. There will be setups covering a variety of training and handling challenges. For example: how to break down a triple for training purposes; identifying suction and factors, paying particular attention to the handler's role dealing with such. Carol will provide comments and suggestions on each run. All attendees are encouraged to ask questions about the working dogs throughout the seminar. The seminar will run Friday from 1:00-5:00; Saturday 7:00-4:00; and Sunday 7:00-4:00, with one hour off for lunch on Saturday and Sunday.

The auditors may bring their dogs and work them after that day's seminar has concluded.
