This seminar will focus on Transition to Advanced level work to help people that want to advance beyond junior and senior hunter level work as well as those that already compete at the higher levels. The seminar will be supplemented with yard and field based drills that will enhance handling and marking concepts. There will be setups covering a variety of training and handling challenges. For example: how to break down a triple for training purposes; identifying suction and factors, paying particular attention to the handler's role dealing with such. Carol will provide comments and suggestions on each run. All attendees are encouraged to ask questions about the working dogs throughout the seminar. The seminar will run Saturday from 7:00-4:00; Sunday 7:00-4:00; and Monday 7:00-noon, with one hour off for lunch on Saturday and Sunday.

Working teams should be running cold land blinds to really get the most out of a senior/master level seminar. **U**nlimited auditor slots and 4 helper spots (any level). The auditors and helpers may bring a dog and work them after that day's seminar has concluded. Club members have until October 1, 2014 to register for working slots, after that date working slots will be open to both club and non-club members.

Cost: Working Slot \$370 – one dog per person. Auditing Slot \$200 – can bring a dog and work when seminar has concluded. Helpers Slot – no registration fee – you will work at the seminar, throwing, building setups, etc. - can bring a dog and work when seminar has concluded.
